Anthony Cerasuolo, 88, of Gloversville passed away on March 23, 2025, with family by his side. He was born in Torre Annunziata, Italy, on June 20, 1936, to Vincent and Nancy Cerasuolo.

When he was a teen, he moved to the U.S. with his family and became a US citizen. He proudly served in the US Army from 1956 to 1958 and was stationed in Korea.
