Clementina T. (Spencer) Mercadante, 95, of Gloversville passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 2, 2020 at Nathan Littauer Nursing Home. She was born September 24, 1925 in Gloversville to the late Frank and Angeline (Riggi) Spencer.

On November 23, 1947 she was married to Pasquale J. Mercadante. They met during the post WWII era while dancing at Sherman's in Caroga Lake, NY. They shared 58 years of marriage prior to Pasquale's death in 2005. She was also predeceased by her beloved son Frank in 2019.
