Eileen Studders passed peacefully at the age of 105 on Wednesday, January 7 at Mountain Valley Hospice. She was born and lived her entire life in Gloversville and was the daughter of Robert and Florence Meyers Studders.

Eileen's life was defined by a love for her family, friends, and community. Eileen also enjoyed classical music and opera. Along with a quick wit and gifted intellect, she was known for her often-feisty personality and was the beloved matriarch of the Studders family.

She was predeceased by her brothers, Robert Studders and Thomas Studders, and nephew Bruce Studders. She is survived by her nieces and nephews, Gail Veeder (Warren), Linda Waber (Thomas), James Studders, Barbara Strine (Stephen), Laura Studders (spouse of Bruce), Judith Westhoven, Karen Studders, Mary Korn (Thomas), John Studders (Joanne), and Susan Studders.
