John P. Damiano, 78, of Gloversville and Jupiter, Fla., passed away unexpectedly, Tuesday, July 16, 2013, at Nathan Littauer Hospital. John was born on January 12, 1935, in Gloversville, N.Y., to the late Anthony and Elizabeth Burrell Damiano. He was a graduate of Gloversville High School.
