Joseph "Joe" S. Paciolla, Jr. of Gloversville passed away on Wednesday, November 21, 2018 after battling a long illness. He was born in Gloversville on June 17, 1941, the son of the late Joseph, Sr. and Jennie Coney Paciolla. Joe was a proud member of the US Coast Guard in the 1960s. He graduated from Gloversville High School, and was the owner of Paciolla's Mens Hair Stylist. He was a barber for almost 60 years, learning the trade from his father.

Joe is survived by his devoted wife Carol Cuccurullo Paciolla, his loving son Joseph III and daughter-in-law Linette, and grandson Cody.
