In the words of John 5:28,29 – "Do not be amazed at this, for the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice and come

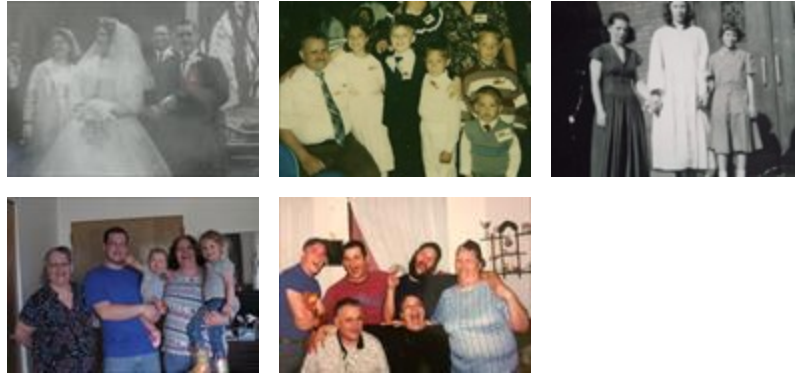
out." We take solace in the hope of reunion, knowing that Juanita's spirit lives on in the embrace of eternity.
