Sharon Louise Park, 79, passed away on Friday March 4, 2022, at the Fulton Center Rehabilitation and Nursing Home from complications due to Alzheimer's. Born on December 14, 1942, in Rochester, NY, she was the daughter of the late Chester Walden and Dorothy Mallard Park. She had one beloved sister, Ridgely Mallard Perham, who predeceased her.

In the late 70's Sharon returned to Gloversville, New York to be near family and worked as a home health aide until she retired,

Sharon enjoyed passing time with a few very close, dear friends and religion always played a significant role in her life. She adored her companion, Whisper the cat, who was kindly adopted by her long-time friend Karen. Sharon was also an avid fan and donor to WMHT and loved
