In 2012 her doctors took her out of work from being severely over radiated.

She was a very loving wife, mother, nana, sister, aunt and cousin, where she loved her job of helping her patients and of being an advocate for them. Tammy loved the outdoors especially camp and water, whether it was the ocean or the lake. She was overjoyed and loved her last job being nana to Jase and Madison, and her special dogs Slugger and Izzy.
