Timothy (Tim) Byrne passed away unexpectedly at home on July 30, 2025 at the age of 62. He was born in Brooklyn, New York on November 13, 1962, to Arthur and Margaret (Novak) Byrne both now deceased.

Tim is survived by his wife and best friend of 32 years, Lisa; brothers James (Jim) and Joseph (Joe) (Lisa); sister Rita; nephews James, Matthew, Daniel, Michael and Kevin; and nieces Ashley and Jasmine.

Tim moved from Brooklyn to Gloversville in December 1969; then to LaCrosse, WI in the fall of 1976, attended LaCrosse Central High School; and ultimately returned to Gloversville in 1978 where he graduated from Gloversville High School in 1981. He also earned Associate of Arts and Sciences degrees in Electrical and Electronics Engineering and Automotive Technology at Fulton-Montgomery Community College and a multitude of certifications in leadership and technology through various educational courses.

Tim was easy-going and had a heart of gold willing to help anyone, as many family and friends are keenly aware. Whether delivering papers for the Leader Herald back in the day, in the quality or automotive fields, gardening, being the family historian, DJ'ing or volunteering with the Red Cross and as an EMT with the Johnstown Area Volunteer Ambulance Corp, Tim's empathy, compassion, and quirky sense of humor and sarcasm showed through - which was greatly needed being an avid New York Jets fan!

Tim's interest in animals began at a very young age caring for frogs and family dogs to adulthood where his passion for cats became apparent. Tim and Lisa cared for and adopted many strays over the years, nursing them through sickness and more. They were his children.

We will forever miss Tim's hearty laugh, meaningful thumbs up in the family chat, jabs at the Chicago Bears and Minnesota Vikings, his recipe experiments, never-ending support of family accomplishments, and Facebook memes and commentary for all to appreciate.
