Virginia C. Huston Lull, 80 of Gloversville passed away on Thursday September 12, 2024. Born in Flushing, NY, September 9, 1944, daughter of the late John and Virginia Wickham Huston.

In 1955 Ginny and her family moved to the local area where she graduated from Broadalbin High School in 1965. After graduation she worked as a baby caregiver at St. Catherine's Center for children in Albany. Later she moved to White Plains and then spent time in Athens, GA. Additionally, she was employed by Sisters of St Joseph Motherhouse in Watertown, NY. In the 1990's she relocated back to Gloversville where she retired. She was a communicant of Church of the Holy Spirit in Gloversville.

Survived by her siblings, Helen Szelusniak of Amsterdam, Judith (Mark) Vickery of Gloversville, and David L. Huston of Raleigh, NC, several nieces, nephews and cousins. Pre-deceased by her husband Arthur Lull and her brother John G. Huston Jr.
