Vito "Peter" D'Errico, 95, of Gloversville died peacefully Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at his home in Gloversville, NY surrounded by his loving family. He was born October 7, 1924 in Gloversville to Tammaro and Carmella D'Errico. He married the love of his life Carmella Raso on September 15, 1946 and spent 71 wonderful years together.

Upon returning from the service, Peter worked in the leather industry as a toggler for over 50 years. Supporting his wife and family meant everything to him. He was so proud of his Italian heritage and his happiest times were when his entire family was together feasting no matter what the occasion. He loved golfing from an early age and golfed into his nineties. He had five holes-in-one! Hot coffee and breakfast with his friends was a special time for him.
