Our family has been rocked to its core with the loss of the love of our lives.

Walter J. Hertik, 81, of Mayfield NY went to be with his Father in Heaven on October 27, 2023, at Ellis Hospital with his loving family by his side. He was the son of the late Walter O. and Julia V. (Smrtic) Hertik.

He graduated from Johnstown High School in 1960 and SUNY Oswego in 1964. He began his outstanding teaching career at Mayfield Central School where he taught Driver's Ed, Industrial Arts and Technology. He retired in 1997 after 33 remarkable years. He loved all the students he had, was a "father" to many and has remained dear friends with so many of them. He enjoyed the faculty as well and made some cherished life-long friends. He was loved right back and was dedicated to the Wall of Fame at the school. He was very proud of his accomplishments there. He recently spoke of how proud he was that he and his class were involved in the design of the garage that stands over by the tennis courts.

Walt (being Walt) just couldn't "retire" so he began working at European Auto working on cars. He had such a passion for it and truly enjoyed his friendship with Nick, Dragon and the guys. He remained there for 19 years and then retired!

His whole heart went into his family and with that, he took us on many family

trips to Florida, especially Disney, Daytona and the Outer Banks. He also loved his visits to Turning Stone- he loved those slots- along with his daily visits to 'Louie's' (Fuel n Food) for his numbers, his special place at the table and talking with everyone there.

As soon as you met Walt, you were a friend. He would help anyone any time and would never expect or want anything in return. He poured his heart and soul into everything he did. He was a much-loved member of the community of Mayfield, and we know you are mourning with us.

Walt delighted in feeding the new duck family and looked forward to it every year. He was like the pied piper- they would follow him up to the feeder all in a row. Then he would cross momma duck and her babies across the street to the lake to safety. This went on for months!

He loved working on cars, helping the grandkids, building things for family, watching nascar races – especially when he was at Daytona – but most of all, just loving his family. There wasn't anything he couldn't do, and he perfected it all.

Walt was totally devoted to his family and so very proud of his grandchildren and great granddaughter. There was always a twinkle in his eye whenever he spoke of them. A greater man we'll never know and are missing him terribly. Our hearts are broken but his smile and his love will live on in our hearts forever.

Walt was predeceased by his parents, sister Jacqueline Wiltey, brother Wayne, sister Barbara Melita and daughter-in-law Candy Hertik. He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Gloria (Paciolla). 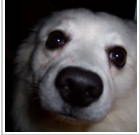

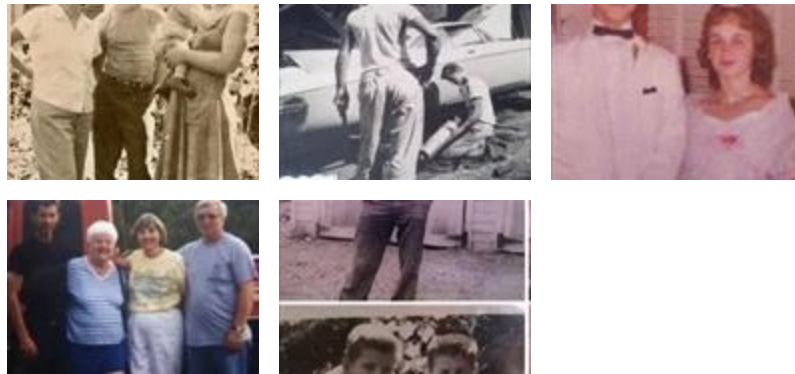
